

Dashboards	Can report on shipping container orders once they are added into the system, featuring information like current container orders, containers arriving within X number of days, and number of items on containers.
Master Container	You can leverage the Master Order Numbers feature to manage multiple containers at one time with ease.
Priority Ranking	By using Attributes, you can create a ranking system so your internal teams are able to process containers based on the given priority, so your most important items are taken care of first.
In-Transit Inventory	By leveraging Acumatica's multiple warehouse functionality, you can create an In Transit Warehouse that your containers will "live" in as they are being transferred from one location to another. This helps businesses put the inventory on their books, so their accounting is buttoned up, while also allowing the flexibility to not count it as ready to ship to customers.
Container Receiving	As your team secures a container that was on the water or road, they are able to validate inventory against purchase orders or invoices.
Embarkment ID	Allows you to quickly filter open Purchase Orders against open containers to identify where they are in their transit. This plays a crucial role in planning when that inventory will be available for use.
Mobile App	When your team is processing shipments at the dock, they are able to use their mobile device with an internet connection to confirm quantities and report any damaged goods.
