Low Total Cost of Ownership (TCO)	Reduce the total cost of ownership over the foreseeable lifetime of the product (at least 3-5 years), including licensing, support, hardware, upgrade, and hosting costs. Be sure to add the cost of additional products required to run the system (such as web server, database server, collaboration tools, and CRM), and include hardware, licensing, and support costs.		~	
Scale as you grow	Accommodate heavier volumes, more resources, and more users as your business grows. Pay only for what you use. Add more resources when you need them.		~	
Multiple deployment options	Choose between deploying in a public cloud using Amazon Web Services (AWS), in a private cloud of your choice, or on premises in your facility.		~	
Flexible licensing options	Choose between subscription or perpetual licensing (ongoing operating expense versus a depreciable capital expense).		~	
Preserve capital for other business initiatives	Deploy in the cloud to reduce the initial cash outlay for hardware and software purchases. Cloud deployments reduce the amount of internal IT staff required for hardware and software support and maintenance.		~	
Charged by resources used, not by user	Pay only for the resources you use, not for the number of users. Make the benefits of ERP available to all employees companywide. Charging by user penalizes growing businesses.		~
