

BUSINESS CHALLENGE

The District of Columbia Cancer Consortium (DCCC) is a non-profit, grant-making charity whose sole purpose is to fight the disproportionately high rates of cancer deaths and diagnoses in the District of Columbia.

DCCC acts as a cancer services clearinghouse to more than 70 member organizations, each of which are also focused on helping people, especially those in medically underserved communities, prevent or survive cancer.

Recently the DCCC saw its funding from government agencies cut significantly. This drove a renewed organizational focus to more efficiently manage its existing resources and ramp up its fund-raising efforts. To accomplish both, it decided to implement an integrated ERP and CRM solution.

SOFTWARE HISTORY AND EXISTING SOLUTION

There is a misconception that NGOs do not need to manage their financial or project details as well as corporations. This is not true because NGOs must manage complex new reporting requirements and deliver on program objectives within stated budgets and timeframes



Prior to Acumatica, the DCCC was using a version of QuickBooks for NGOs that lacked the features it needed to better manage its various programs to help cancer patients and survivors.



WHY ACUMATICA?

DCCC's work has a direct impact on cancer patients and survivors, so it was imperative that the organization select an ERP system built on technology that could meet its needs now and in the future.

Very early on, the DCCC ruled out PCbased accounting packages and explored a variety of high-end ERP solutions, including Sage, NetSuite, Acumatica, and Oracle.

Acumatica was selected because of its ability to easily integrate with third-party

applications and a wealth of included outof-the-box features, such as modules to track finances, projects, and donors.

The fact that Acumatica's pricing model meant charging by the server, rather than by users, was also a significant competitive factor.

RESEARCHING THE ACUMATICA ADVANTAGE

By researching each of the major ERP solutions on the market, the DCCC was able to dismiss claims by Acumatica competitors that Acumatica was too new a company, and that its products were untested.

Said David Castañeda, Director of Finance of the DCCC: "Whenever a fresh young company comes into the scene with a better product and a better pricing structure, it is a huge threat to the status quo. The backlash from legacy competitors is understandable, but also a little disingenuous."
